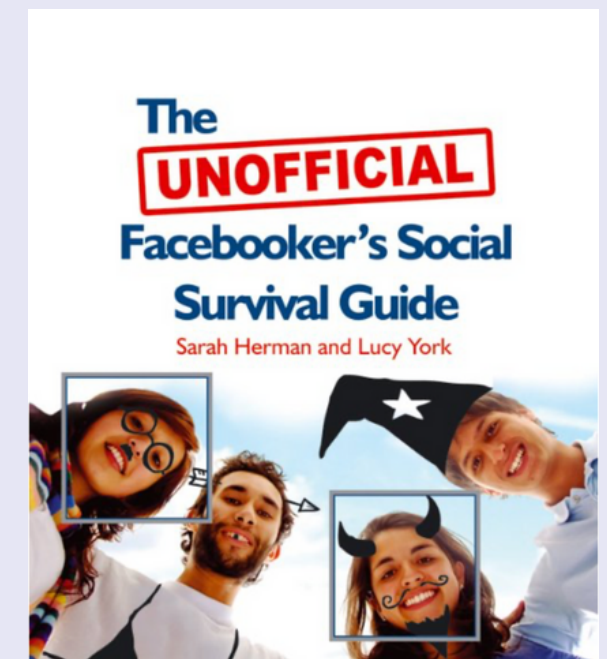
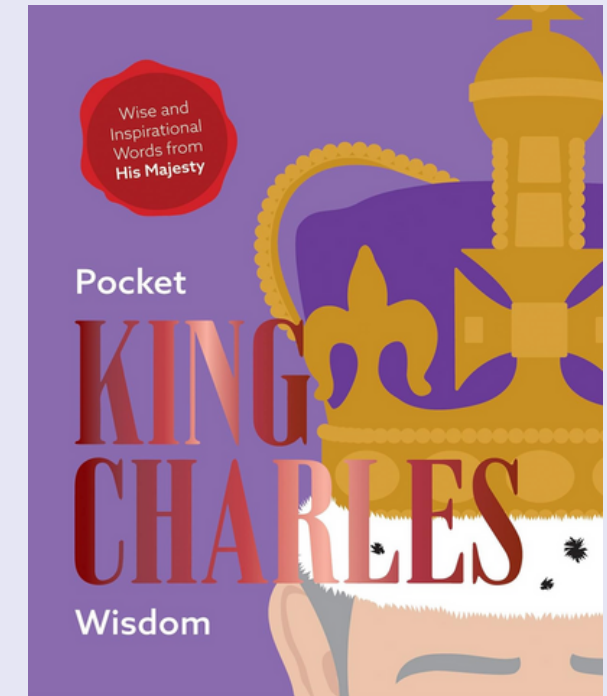
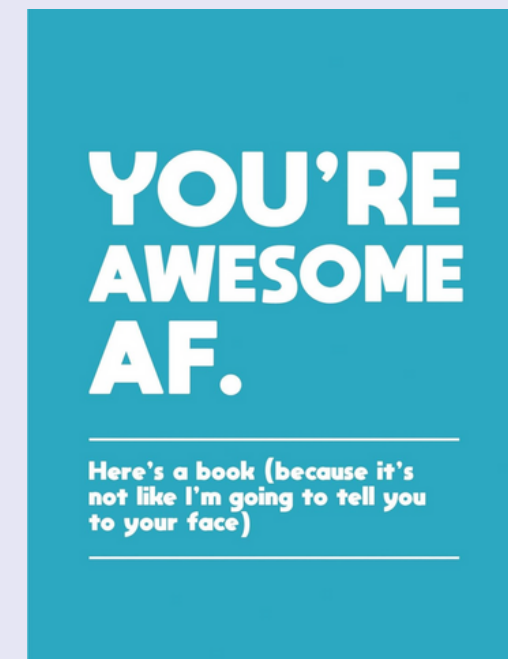
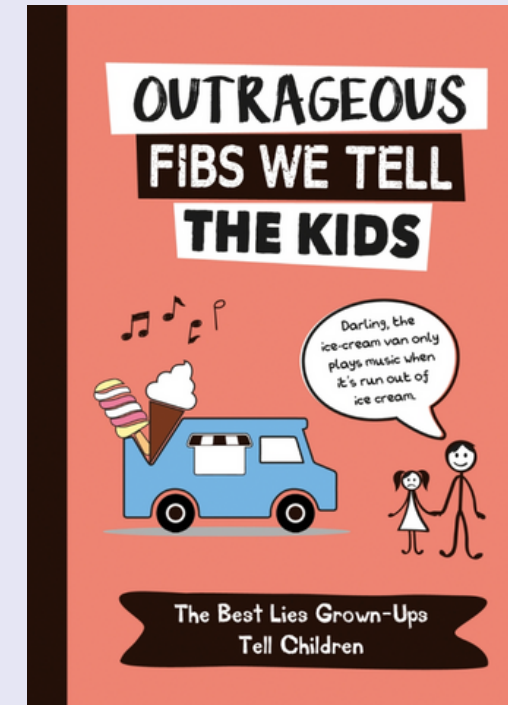
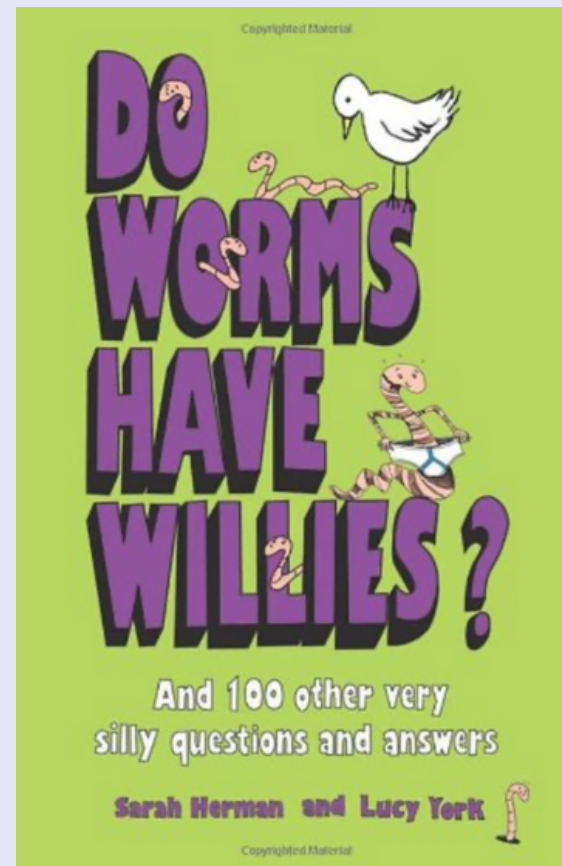
GIFT AND HUMOUR

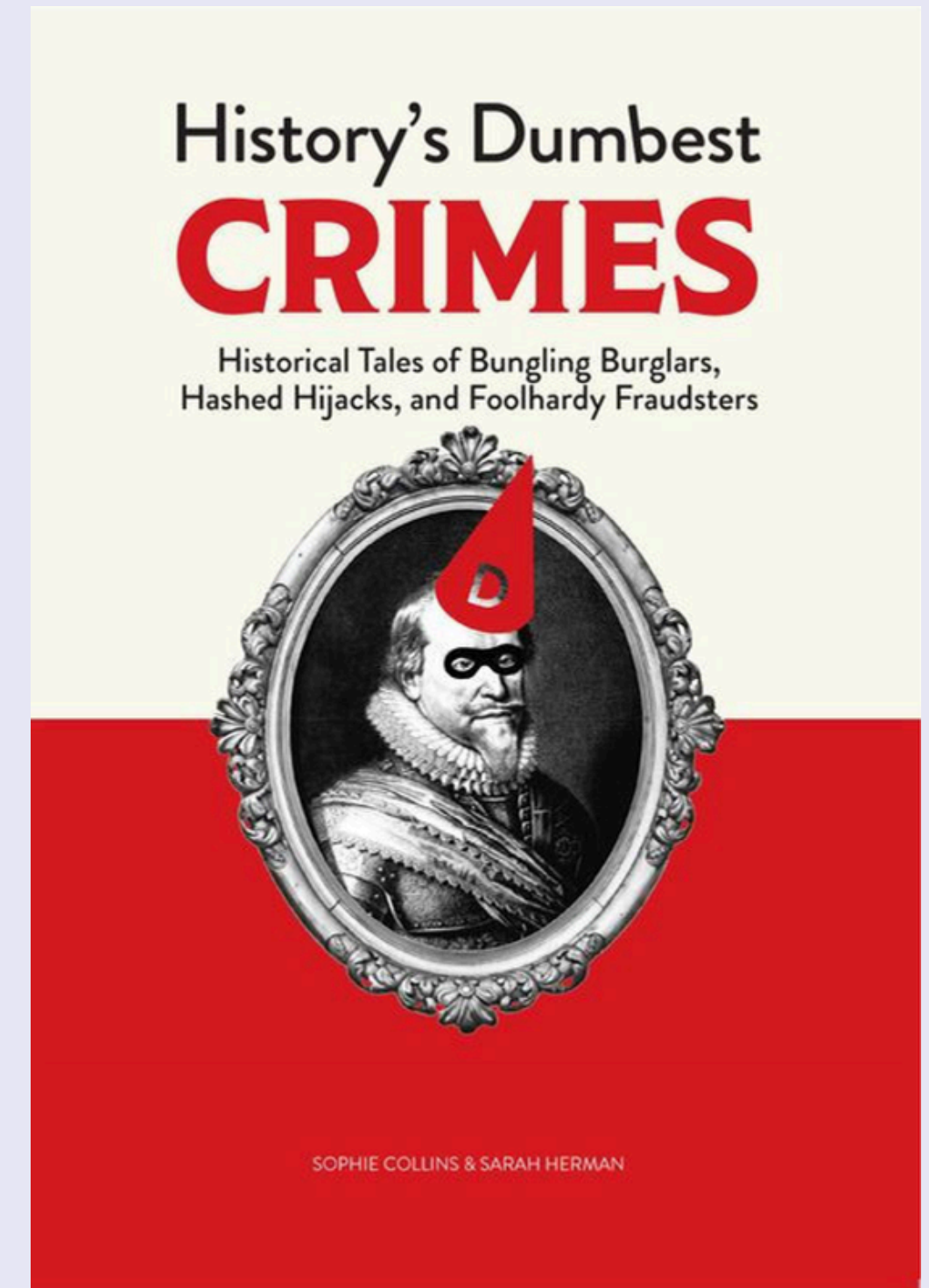
TRUE CRIME
